#### POLICY AND PROCEDURE FOR GET WELL AREA

## **Policy**

Programs establish, follow, and practice, as appropriate, procedures for, at a minimum: (iii) Protection from contagious disease, including appropriate inclusion and exclusion policies for when a child is ill, and from an infectious disease outbreak, including appro-priate notifications of any reportable illness; *Head Start Performance Standards 1302.47 (7)(iii) Safety practices: Administrative safety practices.* 

What if a child becomes ill while in care? (2) Care for the child apart from other children;. *Minimum Standards for Child Care Centers 746.3605 (2).* 

Based on the above policies UTRGV-PSJA-EHS-CCP Program will provide a get-well area to ensure the safety and health of children and staff with the intent to temporarily exclude a child with a short-term injury or an acute or short-term contagious illness, which cannot be readily accommodated. Children who have a suspected/diagnosed communicable disease will be temporarily excluded from the classroom.

## Procedure

- 1. A get-well area will be designated to provide children who have ill like symptoms, a short-term exclusion from the classroom until either the symptoms subside, the child is able to participate in campus activities or parent has arrived to pick up the child.
- 2. The child may rest or play quietly in Get Well Area under the supervision of an Early Head staff member until a parent/guardian can be contacted and child is pick-up.

Note: It is up to the EHS Child Care Center if they have a separate room designated for a get-well area.
