

Family Connections

Allow your baby to explore with the paint as he/she spread it through the paper/poster with their hands. Make a connection with your baby by joining in and spreading the paint together.

Enrichment Activities

Materials inside your Materials Box:

- 1. Coffee filters
- 2. Food Coloring mix
- Cupcake foil pan or cups
- 4. Magazine or Photos of your pets
- 5. Water
- Q-Tips/ brush/eyedropper/Ice (optional)

Procedures:

- 1. Pour food coloring into a cup cake pan or cups with some water.
- 2. Have children paint their coffee filter and set it out to dry.
- Print/Cut of picture of a dog/cat. (Can be from a magazine).
- 4. 4. Glue the dog/cat to the coffee filter and the craft is done.

Special Need Adaptations

Remember to help your baby along the way. If infant is sensible to touching paint. have the infant play with the materials in a less threatenina wav. For example, have the infant use your hands to start touching it, or put objects in or out of the "messy" materials, or push their favorite toy car or favorite plastic tov/animal through it etc.

Enrichment Activities Bathing Pets:

Materials Inside Your Material Box

*Chocolate puddina

*Animal biscuits

*Toy plastic animals

*2 plastic containers

*1 spoon

Procedure:

1.Put the items together

2.Put the chocolate pudding in a bowl.

3. Put the water in the second container.

4. Add the biscuits of plastic animals and animals to the container with the pudding.

5. Encourage the child with his or her hand over his or her hand to feel the pudding mixture and animal biscuits.

6. Encourage the child to bathe the pet (plastic animals) in the water container.

* Animal cookies are to keep the child involved in activity.



Special Need Adaptations

Make the sound of the animal and encourage the child to repeat it with you.

Explore objects in different ways. For example; shake, hit, or pull.

Easily find hidden objects. Put things in a container. Practice taking them out of the container.
