Invite children to act out the rhyme "Humpty Dumpty and Randall Candall as you read it have two children sit any chair to stimulate sitting on a wall. Have a third child help each friend stand up from the chair by offering them a hand. Discuss being helpful and using helpful hands.



 During the first 14 months of life, babies' brains are wiring for trust. All babies need to know that someone is there for them and will come to help them whenever they have a need. 
